## GENERAL INFORMATION

### 1. Format

28 team maximum per age group. Modified double elimination tournament.

Tournament schedule to be determined by number of entries and draw. Games will start as early as 1:00 pm on Friday, July 10th. Five fields will be used (All lighted). The top two (2) teams in the tournament will advance to the ASA/USA Nationals.

### 14u "A" – July 26 – August 2, 2009 – Marietta, GA

1. Teams finishing in first place will have its entry fee paid to the Nationals.

### 2. Registration

The deadline for team rosters is Thursday, July 2, 2009. Only completed ASA Championship Rosters will be accepted. Roster must be signed by each player, parent/guardian and approved by local ASA Commissioner. Official Tournament Entry Form must be submitted. Each player must have a photo ID (Passport, Drivers License,

California ID Card or Virtual Tournament ID Card).

### 3. Entry Fee: \$400.00 PER TEAM

### 4. Draw

The Tournament draw will take place on Monday, July 6<sup>th</sup>, 10am at the Foster City Recreation Center. Tournament brackets will be posted on this web site and e-mailed to the team managers on Wednesday, July 8th.

### 5. Format

Modified Double Elimination Championship Tournament. There will be **NO Championship or "if" game**, the undefeated team of the winner's bracket will be declared the **first place team**. The winner of the loser's bracket final will be second place.

### 6. Check-in

There is **MANDATORY MANAGERS MEETING and CHECK-IN on Friday, July 10, 2009 @ 9am**. The location of the manager's meeting is the Courtyard by Marriott (Fairfield). A representative **MUST** attend the meeting. If no one is there to represent your team, it may affect your team standings in the Official Order of Finish for tied teams. **Any team not checked in prior to their first game will forfeit that game.**

You **MUST** turn in your **Original Championship Roster** signed by your local JO Commissioner when you **check-in** at the **Mandatory Managers** meeting. Other items needed at check-in are copies of players I.D Cards (**if not already sent in to the Nor Cal ASA Office**). All players will be required to have their Photo I.D. Cards present with them at each and every game during the tournament. A Site Director will verify that each player has a Photo I.D. Card sometime during the tournament.

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### 8. Fields

We will be using 5 fields in Vacaville, CA. There are two fields at Nelson Park and three fields at Al Patch Park (Tournament Headquarters).

#### **12. Check-out**

All Team Managers, once their team has been eliminated, must return to Tournament Headquarters to pick up their Original Championship Roster and to inform the Tournament Director of their intentions to advance in ASA Championship Play. Pacific Coast Region rules require the Manager to inform the tournament director of their team's intention to advance to the National Tournament at the completion of the Regional Championships. Managers who fail to inform the Tournament Director of their intentions allows other teams to pick up their players for Championship Play. **Original Rosters will not be mailed back.**
